

## **IMPROVED SERVICE**

- Line 8 from Saint-Eustache to the Montmorency station<sup>1</sup> (±20 min)
- Line 9 from Saint-Jérôme to the Montmorency station (±1 h 30 min)
- Line 59 from Blainville to the Montmorency station<sup>1</sup> (±50 min)

between the Montmorency<sup>1</sup> and Bonaventure stations

#### **EXPRESS BUS SHUTTLE - OPTIONS**



#### OFF-PEAK AND WEEKENDS

- Shuttle 404 from Deux-Montagnes to the Mansfield terminal (±1 h 05 min from 5 to 6 a.m.) (±50 min from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 1 a.m.)

# SHUTTLE 964 - Trainbus Bois-Franc/Côte-Vertu

- Service on weekdays from 5:30 a.m. to 12:45 a.m.
- Travel time of about 15 minutes
- Route synchronized with the departures and arrivals of the rail shuttle
- Use of reserved lanes on rue Grenet during rush hours
- Service with transit priority signals on rue Grenet
- New platform at the Bois-Franc station to pick-up passengers with 3 buses at a time, through all doors

#### Toward the Côte-Vertu station

- Line 144 from Sainte-Dorothée to the Côte-Vertu station (±45 min)

- Line 151 from Sainte-Rose to the Côte-Vertu station (±55 min)

- Line 902 between the Le Carrefour terminal and the Côte-Vertu station (±40 min)

#### +20 min

between the Côte-Vertu and Bonaventure stations

## Toward the Montmorency station

- Line 26 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency station<sup>2</sup> (±40 min)

- Line 903 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency station<sup>2</sup> (±55 min)

between the Montmorency<sup>2</sup> and Bonaventure stations

## **SERVICE MAINTAINED**



#### OFF-PEAK AND WEEKENDS

- Line 26 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency terminal<sup>2</sup> (±30 min)
- Line 903 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency terminal<sup>2</sup> (±50 min)
- Shared taxibus line T26 with a transfer to line 26 (±35 min)



### Free

- → Rail shuttle Deux-Montagnes/Bois-Franc
- → Shuttle 964 Bois-Franc/Côte-Vertu

## **Current users**

# 4 months free - as of January 2020

→ With the annual subscription to the public transit service of the island of Montreal

Monthly pass fare: \$86.50

# **MASCOUCHE LINE**

## Up to 30% discount

 $\rightarrow$  on the monthly pass fare

Minimum fare: \$86.50
