




# Zone D – Outside the ARTM limit

## Municipality of Sainte-Martine (Haut-Saint-Laurent sector)

Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times across the metropolitan area while accompanied by a person aged 14 and over who is supervising them and holds a valid transit fare. This person may not accompany more than five children.
