Introduction

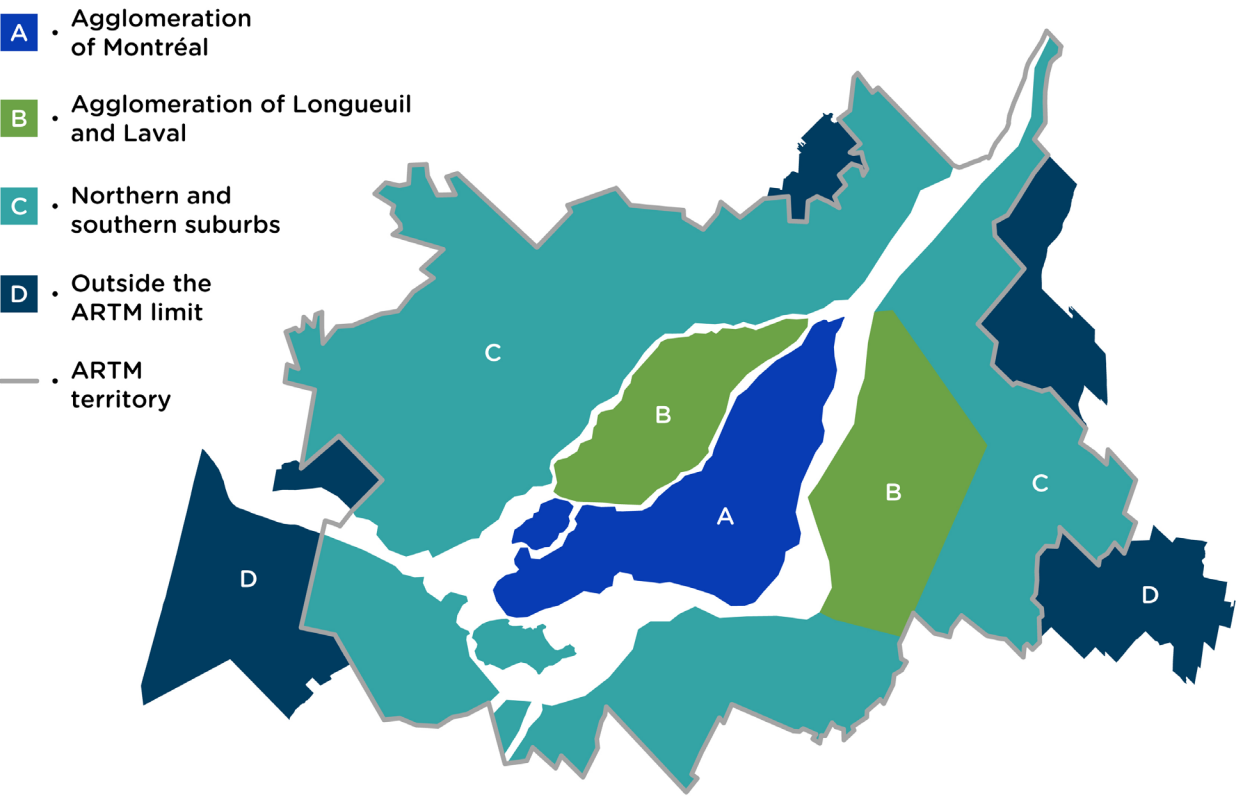
The ARTM has been rolling out the fare reform in its territory since 2021. The project is designed to simplify and harmonize pricing for regular and adapted public transit services in the metropolitan area.

The information below will help you find the right fare for your trip.

1. Identify your departure and arrival zones

There are 4 fare zones.

You can confirm your municipality's fare zone by consulting the [table appended](#) to this fare schedule.



2. Select the appropriate transit fare for your trip

Your fare must be valid in your departure zone, any zones you cross through, and your arrival zone, as well as on the modes of transit you use.

The new **All Modes**, **Bus** and **Out-of-Territory Bus** fares allow you to travel throughout the metropolitan area:



All Modes fares allow you to use all transit modes in or between the zones identified.

Example: One **All Modes AB** fare allows you to travel on all modes of transit running between Montréal (zone A) and Laval (zone B).



The **Bus** fare allows you to use paratransit services in or between zones B and C on the same shore.

The **Out-of-Territory Bus** fare allows you to use paratransit services in or between zones B, C and D on the same shore.



Good to know

The fare schedule includes other transit fares. They provide less flexible use of paratransit services since they are limited to specific sectors or modes.

Travel within **zone A**

Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times while accompanied by a person aged 14 or older who is supervising them. The accompanying person must have a valid fare and may not accompany more than five children aged 6 to 11. Please note that certain conditions apply to free travel for children on paratransit. These conditions must respect the *Paratransit Eligibility policy* of the Ministère des Transports du Québec.

Travel within zone B

Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times while accompanied by a person aged 14 or older who is supervising them. The accompanying person must have a valid fare and may not accompany more than five children aged 6 to 11. Please note that certain conditions apply to free travel for children on paratransit. These conditions must respect the *Paratransit Eligibility policy* of the Ministère des Transports du Québec.

Free for Laval residents aged 65 or older on the STL network.

These conditions must respect the *Paratransit Eligibility policy* of the Ministère des Transports du Québec.

Travel within and between zones C and D

Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times while accompanied by a person aged 14 or older who is supervising them. The accompanying person must have a valid fare and may not accompany more than five children aged 6 to 11. Please note that certain conditions apply to free travel for children on paratransit. These conditions must respect the *Paratransit Eligibility policy* of the Ministère des Transports du Québec.

Always free of charge for travel within and between the municipalities of Carignan, Chambly, Marieville and Richelieu (sector previously served by Handi-Bus).

Free of charge for travel within the city of Saint-Jérôme.

Free for MRC L'Assomption residents aged 65 or older on the L'Assomption sector network.

Free for Terrebonne and Mascouche residents age 65 or older, on the Terrebonne-Mascouche sector network.

Fare arrangements

The *Regulation respecting the terms and conditions for holding and using fares for public transit services in the metropolitan area (A.33.3 – R.3 (2022))* establishes the following conditions for holding and using fares to access public transit services in the metropolitan area.

All transit fares are subject to the *Autorité régionale de transport métropolitain's policy on transit fare exchanges and refunds*.

Age or status	Conditions	Fares
Child (0 to 5 years)	The child must be under the supervision of someone aged 14 or older who has paid for a fare.	Free of charge
Child (6 to 11 years)	The child must be under the supervision of someone aged 14 or older who has paid for a fare. Maximum of 5 children aged 6 to 11 per accompanying person.	Free of charge
Child (6 to 15 years)	To have the preferred (reduced) fare, the child must be between 6 and 15 on October 31 of the current school year and have an OPUS card with photo. Cost of OPUS card: Children aged 6-11: \$6.00 Children aged 12-15: \$15.00	Reduced
Student (16 and over)	A student aged 16 to 64 on October 31 of the current school year who is registered as a full-time student at an educational establishment recognized by the Ministère de l'Éducation (MEQ) or Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur (MES) and has an OPUS card with photo. Cost of OPUS card: \$15.00	Reduced
Person aged 16 to 64	Anyone aged 16 to 64 who is not a full-time student and does not have an OPUS card with photo. Cost of OPUS card: \$6.00	Regular
Senior (65 and over)	Anyone aged 65 and older who has an OPUS card with photo. Cost of OPUS card: \$15.00	Reduced
Person accompanying a handicapped person	Someone who is accompanying a handicapped person travels free of charge when they show: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• On the regular network, a companion card issued by a public transit authority.• On the regular network, a paratransit admission card issued by a public transit authority or paratransit-coded OPUS card. Someone who is accompanying a paratransit user for whom accompaniment is compulsory or for the purpose of familiarization, established by the paratransit admission committee, is exempted from paying for the fare.	Free of charge
