# Introduction

The information below will help you choose the right fare for your trip.

## 1. Identify your departure and arrival zones

There are 4 fare zones.

You can confirm your municipality's fare zone by consulting the [table appended](#) to this fare schedule.

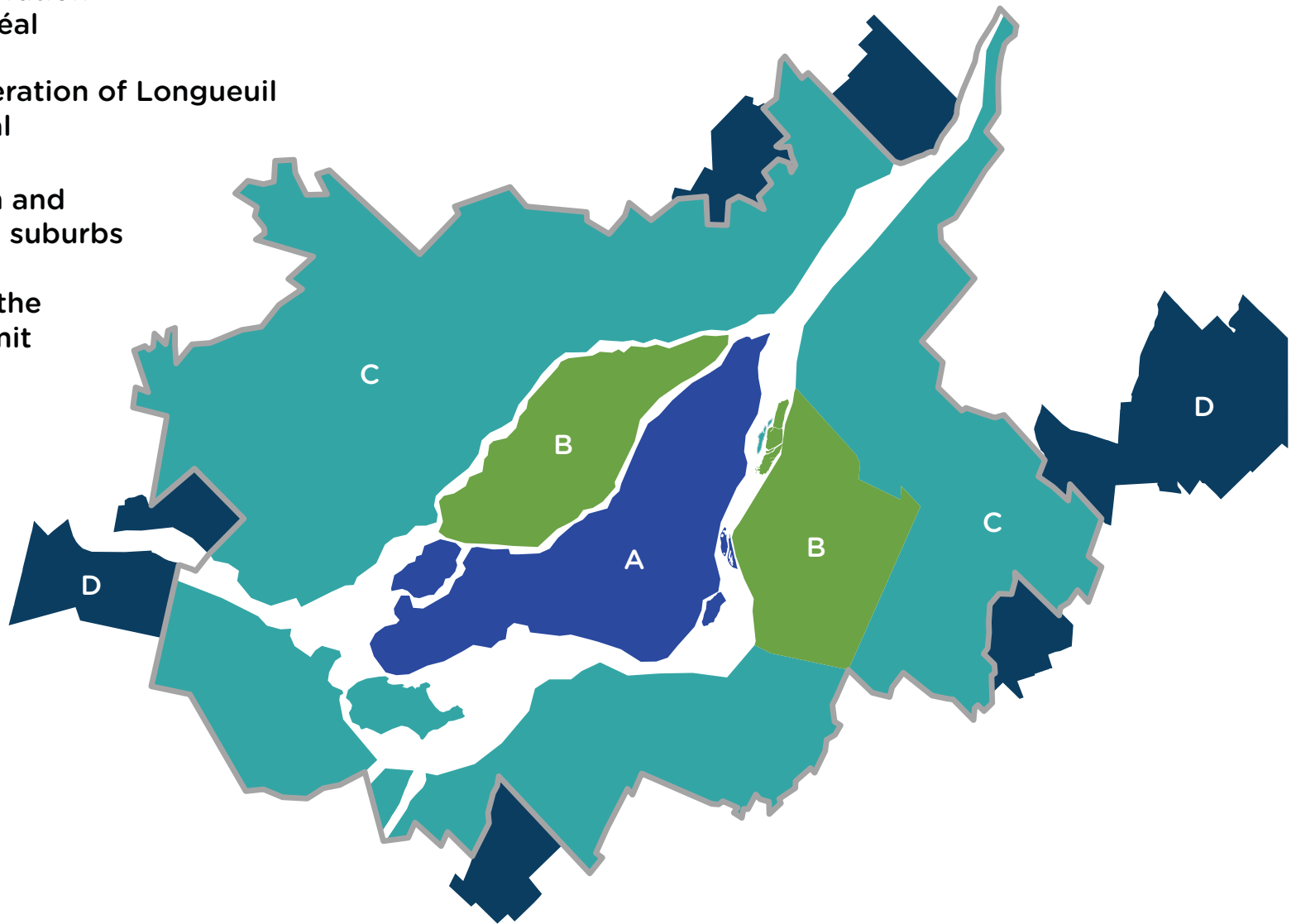
**A** • Agglomeration of Montréal

## 2. Select the correct fare for your trip

Your fare must be valid in your departure zone, any zones you cross through, and your arrival zone, as well as on the modes of transit you use.

The **All Modes**, **Bus** and **Out-of-Territory Bus** fares allow you to travel throughout the metropolitan area:



**All Modes** transit fares allow you to use all transit modes in or between the zones identified.

**Example:** One **All Modes AB** fare allows you to travel on all modes of transit running between Montréal (zone A) and Laval (zone B).



The **Bus** transit fare allows you to use bus services in or between zones A, B and C.

The **Out-of-Territory Bus** fare allows you to use bus services in or between zones C and D, an exo bus lines circulating in zone B.



### Good to know

The fare schedule includes other transit fares. They provide less flexible use of public transit services since they are limited to specific sectors or modes.

# All Modes fares and Unlimited Evening and Unlimited Weekend passes

Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times, while accompanied by a person aged 14 or older who is supervising them. The accompanying person must have a valid and validated fare and may not accompany more than five children aged 6 to 11.

Public transit services offered in zone A are free for residents of Montréal aged 65 and over. Certain conditions apply; check with your transit agency.

# Bus and Out-of-Territory Bus fares

**Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times**, while accompanied by a person aged 14 or older who is supervising them. The accompanying person must have a valid and validated fare and may not accompany more than five children aged 6 to 11.

**Free at all times for travel within:**

- the Chambly-Richelieu-Carignan sector (on local lines only)
- the Le Richelain-Roussillon sector (on local lines only)
- the Sainte-Julie sector (on local lines only)
- the cities of Beloeil and McMasterville, on lines 20B, T80 and exo on demand services in the Vallée-du-Richelieu sector.

**Other free travel** (certain conditions apply; check with your transit agency):

- RTL bus services are free during off-peak hours for Brossard, Boucherville, Longueuil and Saint-Lambert residents aged 65 and over.
- STL bus services are free for Laval residents aged 65 and over.
- Bus services in the L'Assomption sector are free for MRC L'Assomption residents aged 65 and over.
- Bus services in the Terrebonne-Mascouche sector are free for Terrebonne and Mascouche residents aged 65 and over.
- Bus services running in and between zones A, B and C are free for Saint-Jérôme residents aged 65 and over.
- All public transit services offered in zone A are free for Montréal residents aged 65 and over.

## Cash on board

You can also pay for your trip in cash on the bus. Exact change is required, and the cost of the trip will depend on where you board and disembark the same bus.





- To travel in or between zones A and B, the cash fare is \$3.75.
- To travel between zones A and C, the cash fare is \$3.75.
- To travel between zones A and D, the cash fare is \$9.50.
- To travel in or between zones B, C and D, the cash fare is \$3.75.
- To travel on line 747 – YUL Aéroport Montréal-Trudeau / Centre-ville, the cash fare is \$11.25.

**Will you need to continue your trip using another transit service?** Ask your transit agency about the transfer rules associated with paying for your trip on the bus, or purchase your fare using an OPUS card or a occasional smart card before your trip.

# Other transit fares (exo, RTL, STL, STM, river shuttle)

Children aged 11 and under can travel for free on public transit at all times, while accompanied by a person aged 14 or older who is supervising them. The accompanying person must have a valid and validated fare and may not accompany more than five children aged 6 to 11.

# Fare arrangements

The *Regulation respecting the terms and conditions for holding and using fares for public transit services in the metropolitan area* (A.33.3 – R.3 (2022)) establishes the following conditions for holding and using fares to access public transit services in the metropolitan area.

All transit fares are subject to the *Autorité régionale de transport métropolitain's policy on transit fare exchanges and refunds*.

<b>Child</b> (0 to 5 years)	The child must be under the supervision of someone aged 14 or older who holds a valid fare.	Free of charge
<b>Child</b> (6 to 11 years)	The child must be under the supervision of someone aged 14 or older who holds a valid fare. Maximum of 5 children aged 6 to 11 per accompanying person.	Free of charge
<b>Child</b> (6 to 15 years)	To have the preferred (reduced) fare, the child must be between 6 and 15 on October 31 of the current school year and have an OPUS card with photo.  <b>Cost of OPUS card:</b> Children aged 6-11: \$6.00 Children 12-15: \$15.00	Reduced
<b>Student</b> (16 and over)	A student aged 16 to 64 on October 31 of the current school year who is registered as a full-time student at an educational establishment recognized by the Ministère de l'Éducation (MEQ) or Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur (MES) and has an OPUS card with photo.  <b>Cost of OPUS card:</b> \$15.00	Reduced
<b>Person aged 16 to 64</b>	Anyone aged 16 to 64 who is not a full-time student and does not have an OPUS card with photo.  <b>Cost of OPUS card:</b> \$6.00	Regular
<b>Senior</b> (65 and over)	Anyone aged 65 and older who has an OPUS card with photo.  <b>Cost of OPUS card:</b> \$15.00	Reduced
<b>Person accompanying a handicapped person</b>	Someone who is accompanying a handicapped person may ride free of charge when they show: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the regular network, a companion card issued by a public transit agency.</li> <li>• On the regular network, a paratransit admission card issued by a public transit agency or paratransit-coded OPUS card.</li> </ul> Someone who is accompanying a paratransit user for whom accompaniment is compulsory or for the purpose of familiarization, as determined by the paratransit admission committee, may ride without purchasing a transit fare.
